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It' dead simple. When you go to the main window of any of the ARTtopical forums, there's an "ART Radio" link between "Home" and "Posting Rules". Clicking on that brings up a small window, and, at least on Windows, opens the download manager. It tells you about a file named "play.pls", which you want to download to your disk. It's a one line text file and the .pls suffix means that it's a playlist. You could open it with Itunes or Windows Media Player, for example, and then ART Radio would stream though your computer's sound card. For the Squeezebox, move the file to the directory where you keep your files for the Slimserver database access and purt it at the top levelso it will index at your first browsing level. I renamed "play.pls" to ART_Radio.pls so I could easily spot it. Then you bring it up on your Squeezebox display and hit play. It'll take a few seconds to buffer, and then it plays. Worked flawlessly for me for over an hour or so yesterday.
