Those Auricaps are great, aren't they?! Adding additional capacitance (100uF/450V instead of 47uF) to the PS of the Paramours seems to tighten up the bass a bit. Also, the Mod to the Paramours described by VoltSecond a few weeks ago seems to add more detail across the board, including the bass. FWIW, some of the improvement may be coming from the new 2004Jr OPT's breaking in.Have a good Holiday, BillG.
