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Hi Benny, Really small tube amps like the Decware Zen prefer speakers with as low impedance (z-max) as possible. Any of the Pi Thermonic series will work, as will the Theater 4 PI model. Avoid the Pro series as they prefer to see at least ten watts per channel. I think you will find this forum to be fun and educational. Browse around a bit; there's a lot of information about Pi speakers with single ended tube amps. Take care, Steve
