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The port is spec'ed at 2.0" O.D. with 0.030" wall thickness for an inside diameter of 1.94".Did we send you the port material? Because if we did, you'll want to drill to fit. Would it mess up the veneer to do that?If we forgot to send the port, let me know and we'll send it right away.

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When I made mine, I couldn't get the tube to fit through the hole to go flush with the front of the baffle. I subtracted the thickness of the baffle and just glued a piece of the cardboard tubing on the rear of the baffle. It fit close enough, and with an extra coat of glue and some flat black paint throughout it looks good.

Not a big deal, I just figured others have had to deal with it and wanted to know what worked. I haven't veneered, or painted, or leathered (?) the baffle yet. I think I'll proly let gravity hold the tube in some glue as Matts wrote, adding the thickness of the baffle to the port length. Thanks Matts.
