If you don't like the quality, you can always take it to be done by someone else. But if your sound card is good and your tape deck is too, then you'll probably do as well as anyone. If you're wanting to record video as well, then you'll need an image capture board. Those have come waaaaaay down in price in the last 5 years, so that's a reasonable option as well.
