This would be of benefit to my Decware Zen amp, because the impedance load drops to 4 ohms.As an alternative, I am wondering if placing an additional set of drivers on the rear of the Towers would be a viable alternative (or possibly a 2nd Alpha 10 on the front baffle, and the 2nd tweeter on the rear baffle).
