CTS has distributors worldwide, so I think it should be easy to get. But if not, we could ship just those and probably the duties wouldn't be too bad. About the Alpha 10, pretty much any volume from 1.4ft³ to 5.5ft³ tuned to 40Hz works well. Larger boxes yield greater bass extension.
