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In the seventies, I used a super-tweeter from 5kHz and it was advertised to 40kHz. Great sounding part with sizzle and great clarity too. The super-tweeter was a round horn with an aluminum diaphragm, about 3/4" as I recall. I ran 'em with a second order Butterworth and a 20 ohm resistor in shunt across the tweeter.

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I notice that the crossover in the RS tweeter has an inductor(.26mH). I assume this is a 12dB crossover. What if the inductor is removed? Can the crossover point be raised from what I believe is too low? Does a larger cap or a smaller cap than the stock 2.2uF effect such a change? I want the super tweeter to take over for the PSD 2002 in as natural a way as possible(least electronic filtering concurrent with phase coherence) using the natural roll-off of the Eminence tweeter. Thanks.G.

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You'll probably blow the tweeter at very low power levels (like under 10 watts) if you remove the coil. I'm confident you've correctly identified that as a shunt coil forming a second-order high pass filter. Same thing with the crossover point - It probably can't be pushed any lower without damage to the tweeter.
