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Hi Wayne, Have decided to use the 2.36L rear chamber. Unlike the 0.7L chamber, this larger one doesn't make it have that wimpy sound I was talking to you about in the emails. The large one makes it sound just fine, I can tell it makes the rolloff slope on the low end just as steep as the top end (also I measured it), but it doesn't ruin the sound of the horn at all like the small one did. Of course, the academic reasons too, like the reduced possibility of a peak in constrained space, etc. Well, I think its time to start work on the towers again. I hope to have them done within maybe a little over a month, or at least almost done. After getting some feedback on finishing on the Craftsmen forum, I'm going to put Tung oil on the veneer, seems like it will really make them sparkle!
