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That would work just fine, but the Alpha 8's don't go particularly deep. If your room is larger than about 100 ft² and you aren't planning on using a sub, I think you might be happier using Alpha 10's. As for height, if these will be mounted up in the ceiling corners, I might be inclined to angle the tweeters slightly downward.
