Wayne, I notice that the JBL 2370A horn is much more expensive than the Eminence H290 in the Parts Express catalog. What sonic advantages, if any, does the JBL horn have to justify the price difference? Is there anything about the material used to construct it or its design that would make the JBL more desirable than the H290?

The 2370 is an excellent horn and can be used at a lower crossover point. That said, I really like the H290 and don't ned the lower crossover point anyway. I crossover to 1" compresson horns at 1.6kHz in most everything I use them in.

Thats OK, I really like the look of the 4 PI in the plans anyway,and I have the H 290 flares from Pi speakers, (ultra quick delivery by the way) so I'll just stick to the original plan. Looking at the plan,I couldn't think of a way to align things to accomodate the larger horn with out changing the box size/dimensions. On the other hand, you could fill a battleship with things I haven't thought of! With a cross over around 1600 hz I don't see much advantage sonically in using the jbl, but I have a line on 2370a used and like having the JBL part to use. If I use them, I guess it will be like my A-7s, setting on top. On yet the other hand, PI speakers delivered the H 290s in just a few days, at a cost much lower than even used JBL. I appreciate all the input and ideas from Bill and everybody, but I'm going to keep it simple and stick to the plans with the H 290s. Now to find a cabinet builder! Thanks again, Russellc
