Max,Home Depots carry 8x4 sheets of 5/8" and 3/4" MDF. The sheets are actually 97"x49" in size. Most will also carry "Handy-Panels" that are 4x4 and 4x2. If you don't want to rip your own sheet, the best thing to do is to (carefully) draw out a cutting diagram and have the store cut the sheet up for you into panels.Offically, Home Depot will not guarentee accurate cuts, but it's been accurate enough for me (down to 1/32"). Just don't go in Sunday afternoon and expect extra care in service though. Weekday mornings or afternoons are usually the best time.The Craftsman forum has a lot of good advice about building and finishing.Gar.
