With that amp, you should have no problem with any of the Pi speakers. Your amp would have different outputs at different degrees of distortion, but 25 watts would be plenty. After that, if you have corners with about 3' on each wall available, Wayne always recommends the corner horns, 7 series, and they are all great value if you build them yourself. I'm listening to Stage 4's now really enjoy them.
