My favorite 2-way is the 4 Pi Pro system with Edgar horns and Altec 902 drivers. I have run them with single-ended EL34's, 45, 2A3 amps which are all low power tube amps. When I feel brave, I use my McIntosh MC-240 amp with 40wpc and will blow out the windows and be clean as hell. Ron
