I will wait for microdynamic and holographic qualities to emerge as the image is a tiny bit "blurry" but these are new cables with only a couple of hours on them.Compared to my magnet wire "cables" these RC cables sound a bit brighter, maybe a bit harmonically richer but not as transparent at this point; the RC's will stay in the system for quite a while for full appreciation.
