I used this driver in a Audax designed cabinet, installed in a smallclub several years ago. Used an audax tweeter crossed at 6000 and an audax 13 inch mid/woofer with the PR and sounded pretty smooth with four around the floor in the club. I still have a couple kicking around and would like to match it to a midrange conical horn similar to Wayne's because I used their 8 inch pro midrange in a conical horn and what a difference. Very efficient and much more powerful. Had to pad the pad the midrange when used with the Eminence 2001 as it's very efficient.
