Those are definitely luscious speakers!To add a super tweeter, I'd go with a very simple network crossed over very high, like 10kHz. Just use a 1.0 to 2.2uF capacitor in series with the tweeter and a 16 or 20 ohm damper resistor across it. Use the simple physical alignment and it will sound nice when setup this way.
